

## **ARPOA BOARD MEETING**

**5/7/02**

### **President's Report:**

Call for approval of the minutes of the April meeting was made, seconded and approved.

The President noted that since this is the last formal meeting for this year he informed the Board that the first meeting in the fall would be on September 10, at his house.

The President reminded everyone that the proposed horseshoe league would begin after the June annual meeting.

The Vice-President noted that the petition drive was completed with 169 petitions in hand. This is more than the fifty percent plus 1 needed to request the County to modify the ARPOA charter.

### **PWD Report:**

The PWD informed the Board that no further work on the Shoreline project was scheduled at this time. He was waiting on the County to inspect the work done to date. Once approved further cleaning of the area adjacent to the road at Land End would begin. The PWD also informed the Board that three truckloads of topsoil was scheduled to be dropped at the play ground area of the overlook. However, the unanticipated rain has delayed that activity.

Delivery and grading would begin as weather permitted.

Candy Bigelow informed the Board that the high school volunteer group, that provided most of the manpower for the planting of grasses at the shoreline, would be doing a followup visit sometime later this summer. Further work is needed to eliminate the non-native weeds and grasses.

### **Community Development Committee:**

The chairman for this committee was attending a City Planning Board meeting to discuss the variances proposed for the Bay Village property. No further information was available.

### **New Business:**

A resident on Harbor Drive asked the Board to consider enacting a parking restriction on community owned roads. Currently there are a few vehicles that appear to have been abandoned and left on ARPOA property without property registration. The Board agreed that further research was necessary before any answer take place. The President asked

that Toby Johnson be approached to see if he would contact the County for the regulations.

Contact was made with the owner(s) of the golf club to see if they would be interested in selling off the pool. One of the owners stated that an offer if made would be considered.

Next meeting is scheduled for September 10 at the Presidents house.
